The Online Journal of International Sales Law

The Online Journal of International Sales Law will be a freely available academic reviewed journal devoted to publishing student research in the area of international sales law. It is an initiative of the Global Sales Law Project.

The journal will be published quarterly and available through to the Global Sales Law website (www.globalsaleslaw.org).

Contributions are sought on any issues relating to international sales. Articles relating to domestic sales issues will also be published where it is considered they have international relevance. Special editions focussing on particular countries and regions are expected.

When submitting a contribution for consideration, authors must declare they are a current student and identify the course they are studying. It is permitted (and expected) that many contributions will have been previously submitted for assessment as part of fulfilling an academic qualification.

Only contributions of an appropriate standard will be published. That standard will be assessed by independent academic reviewers. The review process will be a blind one, however the Editors will ensure that the reviewer is not associated with the same university as the contributing author.

Contributions may be in any of the official UN languages. Case commentaries should be between 1500 – 3000 words. Substantive articles should be in excess of 3000 words.
